Vineyards

Located in Vistaflores, Tunuyan,
Uco Valley at 1054 meters
above sea level
Silty loam soil, coming from
calcareous rocks.

Harvest & Vinification

Harvested by hand in the second half of April.
Made by maceration at low temperatures and
fermented at high temperatures in small stainless
steel tanks.
Aging in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

To the eye, intense red with purple reflections,
medium-high body.
Fruity on the nose, with notes of red and black fruits
denoting raspberries and blueberries.
Spicy, with toasted and smoky notes provided by the
French oak from its aging.

Alcohol: 13,70%
