TASTING NOTES:

A delicious white wine with a renewed image made from the traditional coupage of local varieties: treixadura, torrontés, albariño, godello, loureira, caíño blanco and lado. A freshness infused with evocative aromas. A well-orchestrated harmony of citrus fruits and flowers in perfect balance on the nose. Intense, delicate and pure on the palate

TERROIR:

12 small plots across just 40 acres of land with varying slopes and aspects that allow the grapes to benefit from different sun exposures and that thrive in the “Sábrego” soil: unique to this region and comprised of decomposed granite, sand and clay.

WINEMAKING:

Exhaustively hand-harvested according to the optimal ripeness of each bunch then transported in small crates back to the winery where each plot and variety is kept separate for individual fermentation in either stainless steel, concrete or oak vats.

AGEING:

10 months on the lees in a combination of stainless steel, concrete, 600L French oak barrels & 1,200L Foudres. Bottled in autumn 2020.

VINTAGE:

The 2019 vintage began with cold and dry weather, including a few frosts. The region experienced abundant rainfall from late January until the arrival of spring in May. A hot, dry summer allowed the vines to remain in good health with no major stress. The harvest ran from September 9th-October 3rd with a mix of sun and rain as is typical in a Galician harvest.
